BREWTOWN RECREATION:

LEAGUE ALGORITHM



Our goal was to create a system that allows teams to be have fun & be competitive in the regular season and, more importantly, give more teams a shot at winning a championship! As such, we've created the Brewtown Algorithm and the caveats on how the algorithm works are listed below:

INITIAL ASSESSMENT

- o The scheduling algorithm considers previous records, head-to-head records AND previous championships.
 - Once the algorithm is complete, teams are categorized into 3 rankings in the scheduling system (Recreational, Standard and Elite)

LEAGUE SCHEDULING

- When the league schedule is created, the following applies:
 - ♣ All Recreational teams will play each other. Their remaining games will be against Standard teams.
 - All Elite teams will play each other. Their remaining games will be against Standard teams.
 - Standard teams will play 80% of their games against other Standard teams, but will also play 1-2 games against Recreational and Elite teams

REGULAR SEASON IMPORTANCE

- The regular season, and how teams compete, will play a major role in how the championship brackets are created.
 - 4 Your overall record will carry tremendous weight as it will dictate the seed you earn for the league championship tournament.
 - Although you won't play all the teams, you will be competing against teams the algorithm deemed as 'similar level' so you'll have plenty of opportunity to face off Head-to-Head and/or against like opponents.
 - As such, the odds are VERY high those same teams are who you will compete against in the league championship tournament.
 - Tiebreakers will be Head-to-Head and/or Like Opponents, then Overall Runs or Points Allowed.
- When the regular season ends, teams will be broken up into <u>Elite</u> and <u>Standard</u> championship brackets.
 - The known Elite teams (those who have won an Elite championship) will automatically play in the Elite bracket
 - Any new team (who has no history to utilize in the above algorithm) but whose regular season record and play on the field dictates an Elite status, will play in the Elite bracket
 - ♣ Any Standard team whose regular season record is in the Top 5%, has a history of playing in championship games and has multiple examples of competitive success against Elite teams, will play in the Elite bracket
 - Any team who wins back-to-back Standard championships (or best 2 out of 3), will play in the Elite bracket
 - ♣ All other teams, both Recreational and Standard will compete in the Standard bracket

END RESULT

○ 2 LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENTS = 2 CHAMPIONS!!
